Falkirk is a historic Scottish town with deep industrial roots, located in the Central Lowlands between Edinburgh and Glasgow.



In recent years, Falkirk has seen significant regeneration and investment. A combined £100 million from the UK and Scottish Governments is helping to support local industries and create new job opportunities across the region. Central to this is the £80 million Falkirk Growth Deal, which is expected to generate approximately 1,660 new jobs over the next 30 years.



Falkirk's identity is built on a proud legacy of ironworks and heavy industry, with world-famous products such as the iconic Carron Company cannons and the original red telephone boxes. Today, modern manufacturing, logistics, and energy continue to drive local employment and innovation.







There are two train stations in Falkirk -Falkirk High & Falkirk Grahamston. Trains travel directly to and from Glasgow, Edinburgh, Stirling & London.



Located in the heart of Falkirk, The

the M9, it is easily reachable from

To the south, the A803 links Falkirk
