Located in the busy tourist town of Rhyl, the White Rose Shopping Centre benefits from being the only shopping centre in this area. It is easily accessible by train, bus, or car and is just a short drive from Rhyl's most popular holiday parks.

Positioned at the heart of the community, the 113,000 sq ft shopping centre connects key parts of the town, offering a direct route from the High Street and being only a short walk from the promenade.

Retail space is available to suit businesses of all sizes, from 217 sq ft units to spacious 8,734 sq ft units. Bespoke space can also be created, subject to availability.































## Discover Rhyl



Rhyl is a historic seaside town in North Wales, located on the north coast along the Irish Sea, approximately 25 miles west of Chester. It is the largest town centre in Denbighshire.



In recent years, Rhyl has undergone significant regeneration and investment. Supported by funding from the Welsh government and Denbighshire County Council, the town is experiencing major development across tourism, leisure, housing and transport. Current projects include a £5.5 million investment in green space enhancements and travel infrastructure, as well as a £300,000 upgrade to the promenade.



Rhyl's identity is shaped by its coastal heritage and longstanding role as a popular seaside destination. Once a thriving Victorian resort known for its pier, promenade, and holiday attractions, the town has a rich history in tourism and entertainment. Today, Rhyl is undergoing a period of transformation, with its economy increasingly driven by sectors such as tourism, leisure, retail and regeneration.







## Getting Here



Rhyl train station is mainly served by Transport for Wales trains, which connect Holyhead to Rhyl in 1h 1m, Shrewsbury to Rhyl in 1h 21m and Llandudno to Rhyl in 24m.

The centre is a short 6 minute walk from Rhyl Train Station.



Centrally located in the heart of Rhyl, the
White Rose Shopping Centre is easily
accessible by road and well connected to the
surrounding area. The A55 expressway
provides convenient access from Chester, the
North West, and the wider North Wales coast,
while local routes link the town to nearby
tourist hotspots and residential communities.

For those arriving by car, the centre offers up to 300 parking spaces, including dedicated disabled and parent & child bays. A lift provides direct access to the mall, ensuring easy access for all visitors.

Between March 2023 and March 2024, the car park welcomed over 84,000 vehicles.
